Spring Break camp was cancelled because the break was over a 2-week period; thus creating a lack of staff for each week. The safety of the children was priority. Spring Break 2024 should occur because Spring Break will be the same week for both educational boards.

Parent volunteering is important, otherwise the camp cannot exist since it is a non-profit organization and not a program run by the city. There are vacant positions. The meeting cannot be adjourned until all positions have been filled. It is a year mandate. Volunteers must be implicated and attend meetings, which is once a month on Wednesdays and every 2 weeks during summer. We currently have a hybrid system, where you can attend the meeting in person or by zoom.



Treasurer's report

As of December 31, 2023, we have \$94,864.00 in the bank.

Grants are not included in the tabulation because we do not know the amount we will receive. We receive them after summer. Also, there was a minimum wage salary increase in May 2023.

Camp Directors' Report

The day camp will be held at Dorval Aquatic and Sports Complex. There will be 4 rooms for the day camp. The entrance will be on the side of Dorval Aquatic and Sports Complex. We will go swimming/parks/outside as much as possible. To register, a camper must have completed kindergarten. Pre-teen program has a weekly special event.

The camp will run from June 26 to August 19, 2023. Camp hours are from 9am-4pm. Activities begin at 9am. Daycare is included. It is important to drop off and pick up your kids during daycare services (between 7:00 and 9:00am and between 4:00 and 6:00pm). Please email or call the day camp if a camper must leave early. A piece of ID with a picture is mandatory at pick up.

The day camp has a no nut policy. As well, campers should wear closed-toe shoes. For the complete list of effects, please consult the Camper's Handbook.

Campers' conduct, such as no violence or running away, is important. After 3x written warnings, camper will not be allowed to come back. The decision of the Parent Committee is final.

All cancellations must be approved by directors', and not the city. The cancellation form is on the website.
